INTORDUCTION:

SEEDS is a non-governmental voluntary organization promoted by a Gandhian worker Mr. S.D. Pandian who had been associating for 8 years with Sarvodaya Movement initiated by Achyarya Vinoba Bhave in the 50s. It is to be noted that both his father and grandfather were also Gandhian Workers and played active roles in the Sarvodaya Movement. With the rich experience gained from the Sarvodaya Movement, he initiated developmental activities in coordination with like-minded individuals in the surroundings of Aruppukottai, Tiruchuli and Karaiyapatti Blocks of Virudhunagar District, Tamilnadu. This initiation subsequently gave birth to SEEDS in the year 1995. SEEDS is a charitable- welfare society registered under act 27/1975 of the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act of 1975, recognized by the Commissioner of Income Tax u/s 12AA r.w. 12A (a) (ii) and approved u/s 80G (v) of Income Tax Act, 1961 and also registered with Ministry of Home Affairs u/s 6(1) of the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act, 1976. SEEDS has also been approved by the Tamilnadu Corporation of Development of Women Ltd. under "Mahalir Thittam" programme

The mandate of the organization is to enable marginalized and disadvantaged rural women to achieve their socio-economic development through a process of organization and participation, and promoting child centred development. In pursuant to this end, **SEEDS** has been reaching out to more than 10,000 families in 55 Villages within the blocks of Aruppukottai, Thiruchuli and Kariyapatti in the Virudhunagar District of Tamilnadu through the implementation of different programmes supported by Local NGOs, Government and Foreign Funding Agencies.

As years go by, our activities also do increase as there are new avenues for development action. As the year **2007 – 2008** is over, the accountability and commitments prompts us to submit this work report for all concerned.

<u>1. WOMEN DEVELOPMENT</u> PROGRAMME:

SEEDS strongly believe that economical sustainability is the only way for women development and therefore SEEDS has so far formed and promoted 541 women SHGs. As a reward for our sincere efforts towards women, **SEEDS** has been **TAMILNADU** approved bv the CORPORATION **FOR** WOMEN **DEVELOPMENT LIMITED** under Mahalir Thittam from 2005-2006 onwards. <u>5. UREKA PEOPLE'S LIBRARY</u> <u>PROGRAMME</u>:

In order to enhance the General Knowledge of the rural children of age group 5 -14, we are running Eureka People's Library Programme in 50 Villages. Each Library is being looked after by a Volunteer in each Village. The books such as, Science fiction, moral education, ancestral stories, disaster management are distributed to children in evening hours everday. Totally 1572 Children are being This benefited. **Programme** supported by AID India, Chennai. We have formed 50 Children's clubs in Aruppukottai. We have conducted the following events.

<u>6.HIV AWARENESS TO THE SHG LEADERS:</u>

We have conducted a one day HIV/AIDS awareness programme to the SHG leaders at SEEDS training centre at athipatti. 30 SHG leaders participated in the training programme and benefited. The Tamilnadu Voluntary Health Association helped for this programme.

7. VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT PLAN:

We served as Nodal Agency for NABARD to organize the people at Keelkudi Village at Tiruchuli Block, Virudhunagar District. We conducted PRA and identified the needs and, resources of the area, formed SHGs and Village Development Committees, arranged to open 200 Nobril Accounts with the service area Bank (Indian Bank). We have also done preliminary start arrangements to а new cooperative Milk Society and submitted proposals to the District Administration.

We give regular trainings to our staff members as we hope that capacity building of the staff is highly essential for the development of the organization. In addition, we conduct monthly review, planning and trainings wherein the staff share their experiences and plan their strategies.
