### Self Help Groups :

SEEDS have organized 70 women SHGs with 1150 women as members from all over Aruppukottai and Thiruchulli blocks. To initiate the thinking of economic independence among the women SEEDS encouraged small savings and micro credit revilement. Of the 70 SHGs 23 of them have been comprised fully of Dalit as members. More than economic development women have been given orientation on collective strength, solidarity and participation in community development to bring about women empowerment.

### **Reproductive and Child Health:**

SEEDS had promoted reproductive and Child Health (RCH) program supported by ministry of Health and Family welfare of the Government of India, New Delhi through their mother NGO Rural Education and Development Society (REDS), Sivagangai.

The objective of the program is to impart Family Planning and Family welfare Education for eligible couples in the age group of 18-45, in Aruppukottai Block, Virudhunagar district. The program was implemented in 11 villages. Covering a population of 15, 049, SEEDS had conducted following awareness programs through cultural,

- a) Safe motherhood
- b) Family Planning and Welfare
- c) Child Health
- d) Health for adolescent girls
- e) Reproductive Tract Infection and Sexually transmitted Diseases
- f) Gender perspective
